1. Domestic Production

(1) March 2012

Mazda's total production volume in March 2012 increased 82.1% compared to March 2011 due to increased production of both passenger and commercial vehicles.

Mazda3 (Axela): 29,345 units (up 97.0% year-on-year)

CX-5: 16,234 units

Mazda2 (Demio): 10,831 units (up 56.8% year-on-year)

(2) April 2011 through March 2012

Mazda's domestic production volume in the period from April 2011 through March 2012 decreased 2.4% compared to the same period last year.

Mazda3 (Axela): 317,899 units (down 12.5% year-on-year)
Mazda2 (Demio) 165,594 units (up 14.3% year-on-year)
Mazda5 (Premacy): 89,180 units (up 9.7% year-on-year)

2. Overseas Production

(1) March 2012

Mazda's overseas production volume in March 2012 decreased 7.8% compared to March 2011, reflecting decreased production of both passenger and commercial vehicles.

[Overseas production of key models in March 2012]

Mazda6: 17,395 units (up 4.9% year-on-year)
Mazda3: 9,390 units (up 11.3% year-on-year)

(2) April 2011 through March 2012

Mazda's total overseas production volume in the period from April 2011 through March 2012 decreased 17.6% year-on-year, due to reduced production of both passenger and commercial vehicles.

(1) March 2012

Mazda's total domestic sales volume in March 2011 increased 55.5% compared to March 2011 due to increased sales of both passenger and commercial vehicles.

Mazda's registered vehicle market share was 5.0% (down0.5 points year-on-year), with a 2.7% share of the micro-mini segment (down0.5 points year-on-year) and a 4.2% total market share (down 0.5 points year-on-year).

Mazda2 (Demio): 9,123 units (up 43.1% year-on-year)

CX-5: 4,623 units

AZ Wagon: 3,664 units (up 40.1% year-on-year)

(2) April 2011 through March 2012

Mazda's total domestic sales volume in the period from April 2011 through March 2012 remained almost the same as the same period last year (down 0.2% year-on-year) despite decreased production of commercial vehicles.

Mazda's registered vehicle market share was 5.1% (down 0.2 points year-on-year), with a 2.9% share of the micro-mini segment (unchanged year-on-year) and a 4.3% total market share (down 0.2 points year-on-year).

(1) March 2012

Mazda's export volume in March 2012 increased 33.8% compared to March 2011 due to increased shipments to North America and Oceania.

Mazda3: 28,031 units (up 52.3% year-on-year)

CX-5: 12,814 units

(2) April 2011 through March 2012

Mazda's export volume in the period from April 2011 through March 2012 decreased 9.5% year-on-year, reflecting reduced shipments to North America, Europe and other regions.
